Maria: Her birth year is calculated from the statement in the Tragheimerweide records that she was 37 at the time of her death: Tragheimerweide records, page 241.
 - iv. **Hans Neumann** #267588, b. in Insel Kueche, Marienwerder, Prussia. He married _____ #267589.
 - v. **Peter Neumann** #45730, b. Abt 1755, d. Bef 1794. His first name is verified by the 1835 Molotschna Census entry for his son, Jacob. He married Cornelia Huebert #45725, 19 Nov 1780, b. Abt 1758, d. 1808, immigrated 1803 in Molotschna Colony, South Russia. Cornelia: The record of her first marriage, found in the diary of Aeltester Gerhard Wiebe of the Elbing/Ellerwald congregation, gives her name as Cornelia. Two separate immigration records (B.H. Unruh p. 341, and P. Rempel p. 70) give her name as Elenora and Elenore. In the 1808 census of the Molotschna colony (village of Muensterberg) she is called Cornelia and in the 1811 Molotschna census she is called Cornelia. The fact that she is in the 1811 census means that the death year of 1808 is wrong. Her ages in the immigration lists indicate that she was born in 1758. Her ages in the two village lists indicate that she was born in 1756.

He married Margaretha Abrams #267563, Abt 1764 in Klein Schardau, Stuhm, Prussia, b. Abt 4 Jan 1745 in Klein Schardau, Stuhm, Prussia, d. 13 May 1804 in Klein Schardau, Stuhm, Prussia. Margaretha: Tragheimerweide records, page 254: died age 59Y4M9D.

If he married, and no record of any marriage has been found, his widow may have been the "Widow Neuman" that married Erdman Linger on 10 May 1804. However, I prefer the widow of Abraham Neuman of Schulwiese for that. He married Maria Beyer #265959, b. Abt 1770. Maria: She was 30 years at marriage to Franz.

- iii. Peter Neumann #267566, b. 25 Jan 1779 in Klein Schardau, Stuhm, Prussia, d. 15 Nov 1852 in Gross Sanskau, Schwetz, Prussia. He resided in Klein Schardau, Prussia at the time of his baptism. Tragheimerweide records, page 314-15: died age 75Y9M21D. He married Elisabeth Nickel #120041, in Klein Schardau, Stuhm, Prussia, b. 6 Jan 1780 in Stuhm, Stuhm, Prussia (daughter of Gerhard "Gert" Nickel #118532 [1749 - 1813] and Anna Jantzen #118534), d. 7 Feb 1854 in Gross Sanskau, Schwetz, Prussia. Elisabeth: She resided in Stuhm, Prussia at the time of her baptism.
- iv. Jacob Andreas Neumann #52940, b. 4 Sep 1780 in Klein Schardau, Stuhm, Prussia, d. 7 Jul 1849 in Molotschna Colony, South Russia. Tragheimerweide records, page 211: widower when married 1815. He resided in Klein Schardau, Prussia at the time of his baptism. In the 1835 census, he is listed at Rudnerweide #32, and is said to have come to Russia in 1818. The entry for Grossweide #4 says he moved from there in 1826. He married (1) _____ #52941. He married (2) Maria "Margaretha" Peters #307562, 12 Mar 1815 in Hintersee, Stuhm, Prussia, b. 15 Jan 1793 in Hintersee, Stuhm, Prussia (daughter of Franz Peters #308997 [1752 - 1813] and Anna Edsen #310047 [1749 - 1815]), d. 20 Jan 1849 in Molotschna Colony, South Russia. Maria: At the time of her baptism she resided at Hintersee, Prussia. One record calls her Margaretha, but the Tragheimerweide record is clear.

3. **David Andreas³ Neumann #55000** (Andreas², Abraham¹ Neuman), b. 23 Feb 1783 in Klein Schardau, Stuhm, Prussia, immigrated 1819. He resided in Klein Schardau, Prussia at the time of his baptism. One record says he was born 23 Mar 1783. In the 1835 census, he is listed at Marienthal #4, and is said to have come to Russia in 1819. His passport, dated 2/14 Sept 1819, says he came from Kueche, Prussia. He married (1) Katharina Foth #55001, 27 Apr 1815 in Insel Kueche, Marienwerder, Prussia, b. 2 Mar 1786 in Insel Kueche, Marienwerder, Prussia (daughter of Heinrich Voth #310946 [1739 - 1810] and _____ #310947 [1740 - 1810]), immigrated 1819. Katharina resided in Kueche, Prussia at the time of her baptism. The 1835 Molotschna Census gives an age for her which indicates that she was born about 1784, but the Tragheimerweide records say she was 29 years old at the time of her marriage in 1815; (2) Sara Dahl #8021, b. 1787 in Zieglershuben, Stuhm, Prussia (daughter of Paul Dahl #8018 [1754 - 1813] and _____ #8019 [- 1813]), immigrated 1829. Sara resided in Zieglershuben, Prussia at the time of her baptism. In the 1835 census, she is listed at Marienthal #5, the home of Gerhard Peter Schroeder. Jakob Becker (b. 17 Jul 1934) states she migrated from Prussia to Russia in 1829. Sara lived next door to David Andreas Neumann and they were never married; her child, David David Neumann, was born out of wedlock.

She married Franz Daniel Wiens #6396, Nov 1832, b. 15 Oct 1802 in Fuerstenauerweide, Gross Werder, Prussia (son of Daniel Wiens #46971 [1764 - 1810] and Katharina Wiebe #46972 [1767 -]), d. 31 May 1881 in Jansen, Nebraska, immigrated 17 Jul 1874 in S. S. Austrian; arrived Quebec City, Quebec. Franz: In the 1835 census, he is listed at Tiege #27, where it says he came to Russia in 1803. Delbert Plett's "Profile" says he was born 15 Sept. However, the Fuerstenau Church records say he was born 15 Oct.

Abt 1821 in Pastwa, Molotschna, South Russia (son of Peter Paul Vogt #52211 [1783 -] and Anna Heinrichs #52212 [1778 -]). Peter: The 1835 Molotschna Colony Census entry for him says he transferred to Marienthal in 1849. In the 1847 Molotschna Colony Voters List he is listed at Marienthal #5. He was residing in Marienthal, Molotschna Colony in 1854 per the Molotschna School Registers. He lived at Marienthal #24 in the Molotschna Colony at one time as well. Carol Friesen's database says that he was born in 1814 and died in 1857. However, that information may actually pertain to Peter Vogt (b. 11 Nov 1814) #102168.

4. **David David⁴ Neumann** #267389 (David Andreas³, Andreas², Abraham¹ Neuman), b. 23 Sep 1816 in Klein Schardau, Stuhm, Prussia, d. 28 Jul 1855 in Halbstadt, Molotschna, South Russia. In the 1835 census, he is listed at Marienthal #5, the home of Gerhard Peter Schroeder, along with his mother. Was Schroeder or his wife a relative? The Tragheimerweide records page 74: born out of wedlock to Sara Dahl and the Busau records confirm that Sara Dahl was his mother. David was the illegitimate son of David Neumann and Sara Dahl, according to the 1835 Molotschna census. He married Katharina Goossen #102879, 15 Nov 1838 in Halbstadt, Molotschna, South Russia, b. Abt 1816 in Prussia (daughter of Martin Heinrich Goossen #102877 [1791 -] and Katharina Hamm #102878 [1793 -]). Katharina: One Neumann family record calls her "Katharina Rempel," but the Busau Mennonite records are quite clear!

She had a total of 9 children with Toews, 5 daughters and 4 sons. 2 sons died in infancy, 1 daughter as a young woman and 3 daughters already married. One record says her given name was Sarah. census he was residing in Rudnerweide. He later transferred to the Rueckenau church. Busau church book vol. 1, p. 22, says he was baptized on Pentecost 1868. She married (2) Gerhard Hildebrand #64105, 12 Feb 1902, b. 30 Dec 1854 in Russia (son of Peter Hildebrand #1116290), d. 12 May 1922 in Frazer, Montana, immigrated 1908 in United States. Gerhard: In the 1897 Vassilyevka, Naumenko Colony Census he is listed at #32. The census states that he was previously from Schoenau, Molotschna Colony. The Hildebrandts lived in Carpenter, S. Dakota. In 1911 they moved to Great Deer, SK. He had 10 children at the time of his marriage to Katharina Neuman.

- ii. Johann Neumann #512141, b. 6 Jun 1851 in Halbstadt, Molotschna, South Russia, d. 2 Mar 1903 in South Russia. Busau Church Book Vol. 1, p. 34 states he was born either 16 or 26 Jun 1851. He married Sara Regehr #512140, 8 Dec 1877 in Saribasch, Crimea, South Russia, b. 13 Aug 1858 in Rosenhof-Brodsky Estate, Taurida, South Russia (daughter of Aron Abraham Regehr #221672 [1822 - 1881] and Sara Thiessen #221673 [1825 - 1905]), d. 1 Apr 1897 in Saribasch, Crimea, South Russia. Sara: The Elmer Regier submission says she died 11 Apr 1897.

6. **Heinrich Dietrich⁶ Neumann #266545** (Dietrich David⁵, David David⁴, David Andreas³, Andreas², Abraham¹ Neuman), b. 30 Jul 1885 in Sparrau, Molotschna, South Russia, d. 21 Jun 1955 in Chilliwack, British Columbia, buried 26 Jun 1955 in Chilliwack, British Columbia, immigrated 24 Nov 1926 in Canada. Became a member of Greendale M.B. Church in 1945. Died in a car accident. One record says he died 21 June 1955. He married Sara Wiebe #266546, 15 Oct 1909 in Siberia, b. 14 Jul 1890 in Blumenfeld, Nepluyevka, South Russia (daughter of Jacob Jacob Wiebe #267508 [1866 - 1921] and Elisabeth Schellenberg #50383 [1864 - 1922]), d. 13 Jul 1958 in Chilliwack, British Columbia, buried 14 Jul 1958, immigrated 1926 in Canada. Sara: In the early years in Saskatchewan and later, Alberta, it was a sad event when the older sons took their leave from home to venture elsewhere in search of work, as in the case of Henry leaving for B.C. mother (grandmother Neumann) would take the grammophone and put on the record "God be with you till we meet again". They sang along and then stood at the window until the boy(s) were out of sight. they might not return home for several years. One record says that she died 10 July 1958 in Abbotsford, B.C.

Heinrich and Sara lived in Hague, SK for 6 years, 13 in Alberta, 1945 to Chilliwack, BC. They had 9 sons and 7 daughters, 2 sons and 2 daughters died.

She had a happy childhood. In 1926 the family immigrated to Canada. They moved to a farm in Bredenbury, Sask. in 1928 and to Gem, Alta. in 1932. In 1936 she moved to B.C. She worked in Vancouver and attended Bible school. She was baptized in 1936 and joined Yarrow (B.C.) MB Church. In 1937 she moved to Calgary and found work.
